Opening Question: Have you ever felt that the foundations of your life have been shaken? How did you respond?

READ 1-3

- What do you think was David's situation?
- How might it relate to us?
- In what ways can you relate to the fear and uncertainty expressed here?

READ v4-7

- What does this teach about the Lord's place and presence?
- What does this teach about the Lord's oversight?
- How does this Psalm point us to the Lord Jesus?
- The righteous and the wicked are in view. What does this mean for us today?
- What hope do we encounter here?

APPLICATION

- Describe how you might carefully share these truths with someone who is struggling with worry or anxiety.
- How might this Psalm help when you see wickedness and injustice in the world?
- Who can you be praying for? How might you encourage them to find refuge in the Lord?
